

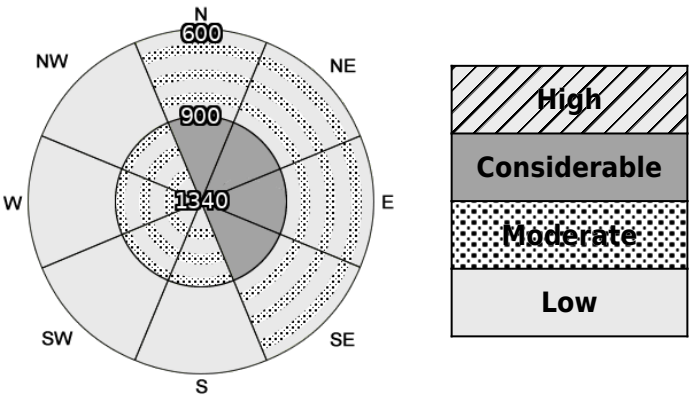

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 01/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will start to refreeze and consolidate during the day. Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered gullies and hollows, and on slopes with mainly North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres where avalanches are likely. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain is expected to continue into the night at all elevations, possibly turning to snow for a time at high levels, with very strong South-Westerly winds. The freezing level is expected to drop to around 600 metres by morning and during the day winds will be very strong Westerly with snow showers.
