

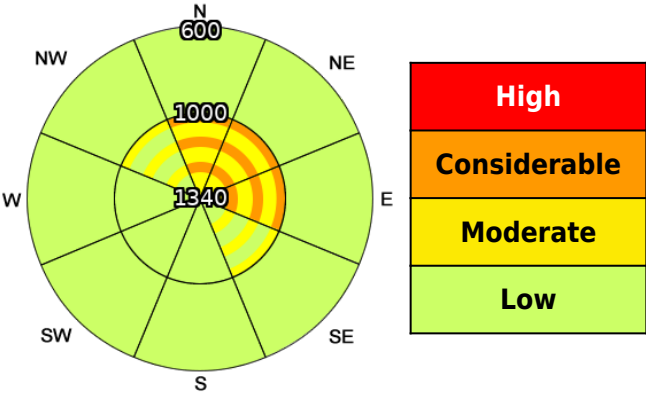

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will become moist overnight and begin to freeze again during the day. Localised areas of fresh unstable windslab will form as the freezing level drops later in the day. Fresh snow accumulations will mainly be on sheltered North, North-East and East aspects above 1000m. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy rain at all levels overnight followed by snow showers above 750m during the day. Strong South-West winds

Comments

Thaw overnight followed by colder temperatures on Wednesday should continue to improve the climbing conditions. Remaining windy
