

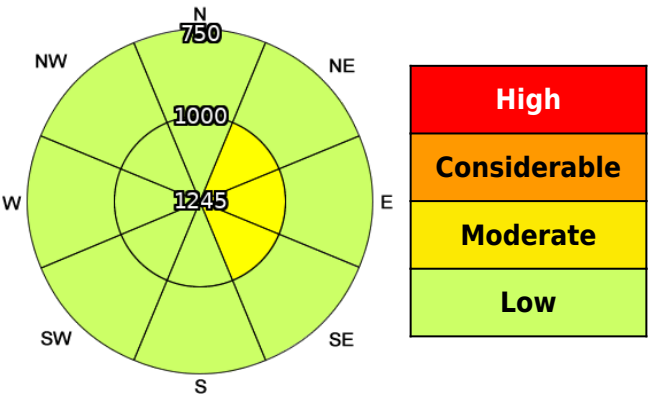

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will re-freeze during the day and become generally well bonded and stable at all levels and on all aspects. However some new localised accumulations of windslab will form in sheltered hollows on mainly steep Easterly aspects above 950 metres, these will be small and isolated. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will be above summit levels but will lower to 1000 metres in the day. Rain at all levels overnight will turn to sleet and snow showers in the daytime as it gets colder. Winds very strong South-Westerly will be Westerly in the day.

Comments

Good snow ice throughout area. Very hard and icy with serious run outs.
