

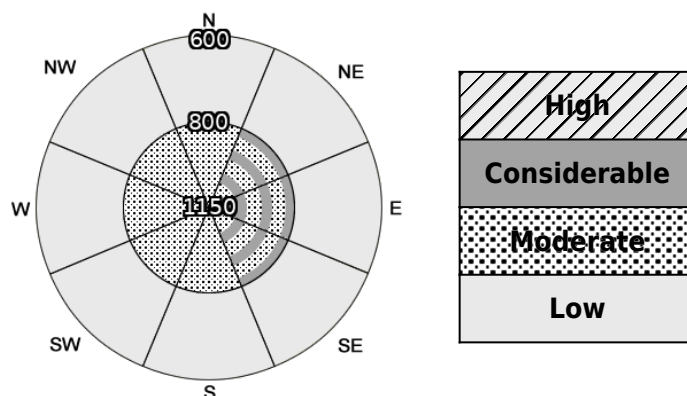

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 02/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be an unstable period as the thaw conditions become established overnight. But as the freezing level drops during the morning the snowpack will start to consolidate again. Cornices will be a significant hazard and will be prone to collapse. New poorly bonded accumulations will develop on North East, East and South East aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a windy wet night with the freezing level well above the summits. During the morning the freezing level will drop to around 1000 metres and there will be snow showers falling on Westerly winds.

Comments

Cornices will provide a significant hazard.
