

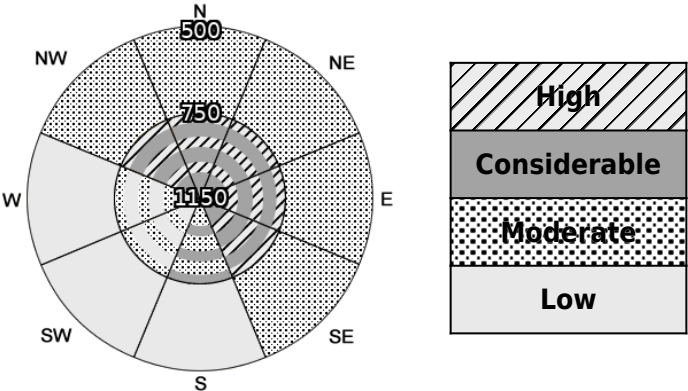

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 03/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will refreeze in the colder conditions. Fresh poorly bonded windslab will be deposited in sheltered gullies, hollows and on slopes with mainly North-West through North and East to South-East aspects above 750 metres, here avalanches will occur. Cross loading will affect other aspects. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy snow showers are expected overnight with very strong Westerly winds. During the day further snowfall is expected, especially during the afternoon, with very strong South-South-Westerly winds and a freezing level of 700 metres.
