



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of unstable windslab will continue to form overnight. During the day, heavy precipitation with the freezing level rising to 1200m will create further instabilities within the snowpack. Avalanches will occur on many North, North-East and East aspects above 800m. Instabilities will also be present in other locations. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers and strong Westerly winds will continue overnight. During the afternoon a period of heavy precipitation with rising temperatures is expected.
