

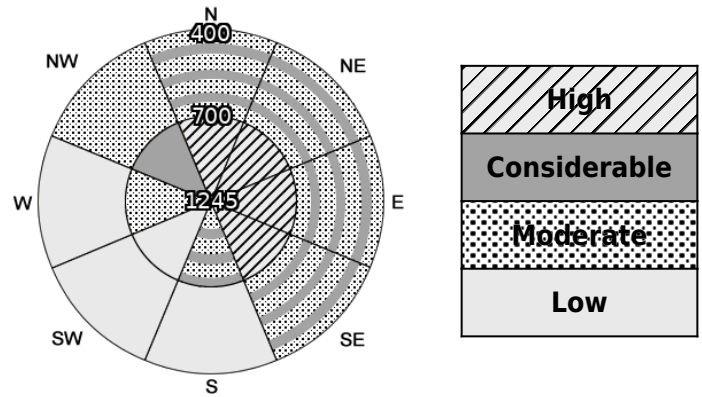

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Heavy drifting will produce unstable windslab accumulations on mainly North through East to South-Easterly aspects above 750 metres where avalanches will occur. Other aspects will be affected with accumulations of poorly bonded windslab due to cross loading. Wind exposed slopes will be stable. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, winds will be very strong West-South-Westerly with snow falling to 300 metres. In the day, heavy snowfall is expected with strong South-South-Westerly winds and a freezing level of 500 metres which could rise above summit levels later in the day.
