



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 05/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

As the temperature lowers the snowpack will consolidate and stabilise. Localised instabilities will remain on steep Northerly through East to South aspects above 950 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will become firm and mostly stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry with strong Westerly winds. The freezing level will quickly fall to 600 metres overnight, lowering to 500 metres during the day.

Comments

Freezing level rose by 6 degrees C in just two hours just after midday today.
