

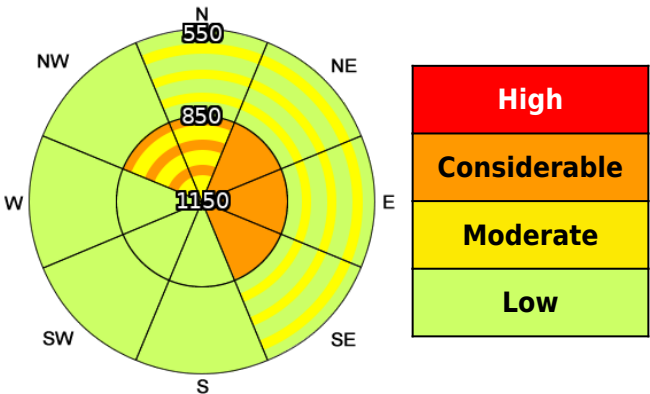

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 06/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New deposits of weakly bonded windslab will accumulate on the re-frozen surface layer mainly on sheltered North-East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Some cross loading will take place, depositing poorly bonded snow onto some other aspects especially sheltered gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight light snow showers above 600 metres with strong Westerly winds. During the day the winds will abate becoming South-Westerly and snow showers will increase in frequency and intensity as the day progresses. The freezing level will around 500 metres.

Comments

Above 700 metres the snowpack surface is firm and icy in places particularly on windward aspects. The new snow amounts are not certain.
