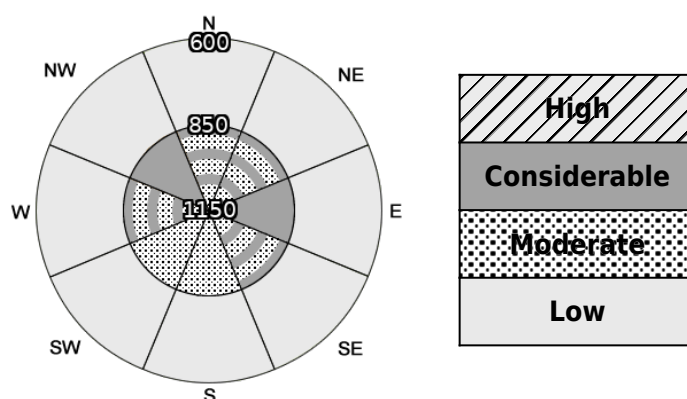


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 06/02/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

New weakly bonded slab will form mainly on North-West aspects above 850 metres. Isolated areas of older instabilities will exist on mainly Easterly aspects above 850 metres, avalanches are likely in these areas. Recent large cornice development may also be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A period of heavy snow is forecast for Sunday. There will be Westerly winds initially, backing to South-East during the snow fall. Summit temperatures will remain below freezing.

Comments

Full winter cycle expected with next snow cycle putting snow in different aspects. Changes in terrain aspect need to be watched carefully.
