

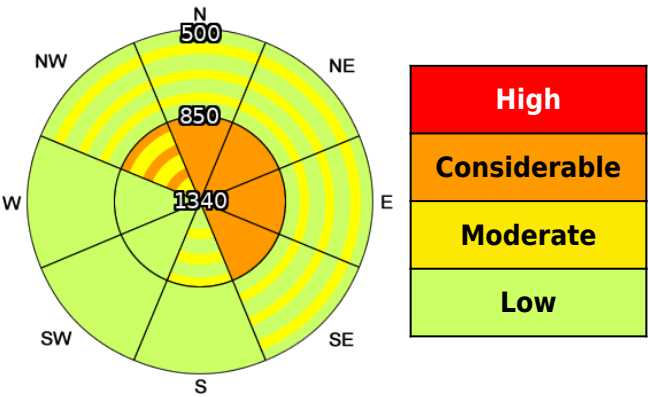

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered gullies, hollows and on slopes with mainly North-West through North and East to South-East aspect above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers are expected overnight with strong Westerly winds. During the day heavier snow showers are expected with moderate to strong South-Westerly winds and a freezing level around 600 metres.

Comments

Above 800 metres the surface of the old snowpack is firm and icy in places, especially on wind scoured slopes.
