



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh deposits of windslab will develop with the arrival of snow showers during the day. Where these accumulate and achieve depth new snow instabilities will exist, as gully exits and flanks cross-load with new deposits on steep North through East to South East aspects above 750 metres. Stability will be good on all old and wind scoured locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry and cool overnight before further snow showers are accompanied by increasingly strong Westerly winds. Freezing levels will lower from 750 metres to around 500 metres.
