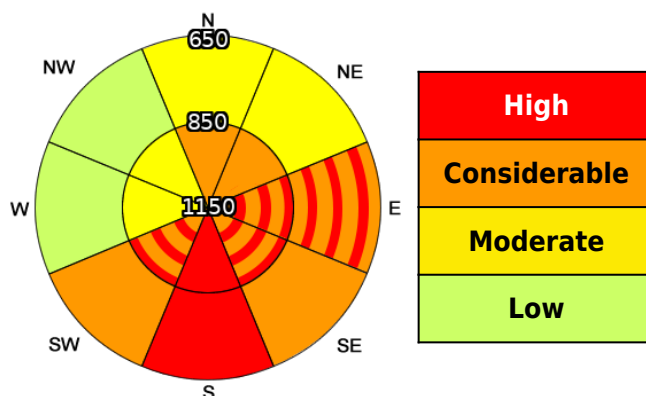


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE HIGH**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 08/02/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be very weakly bonded windslab accumulations on mainly East to Southerly aspects above 650 metres. This slab, in places over one metre thick, is sitting on very soft snow above the old snow ice surface, here avalanches will occur due to the rising freezing level and limited consolidation time since the storm. Instabilities will also exist on North to East aspects above 650 metres and areas prone to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be High.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A dry forecast period is expected with overnight, strong Westerly winds which will decrease slightly in the day. The freezing level will rise to 1000 metres later.

Big cornice development has now moved to Southerly aspects.
