

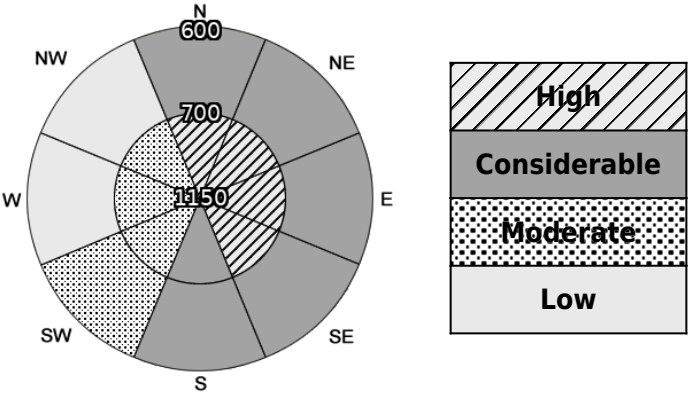

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 09/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The onset of rain and rising temperatures will see a period when the weakly bonded storm snow will avalanche on mainly steep North through East to South-East aspects above 700 metres. Less widespread instability will exist at lower elevations. The new snow has consolidated somewhat but remains overlying a weakly bonded layer at the snow ice. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be sleet mixed with snow followed on Wednesday by rain to high elevations. Winds will back from Westerly to Southerly then veer South-West, moderate to strong. The freezing level will be above the summits

Comments

A period of High hazard persists with the forecast warming and onset of rain.
