

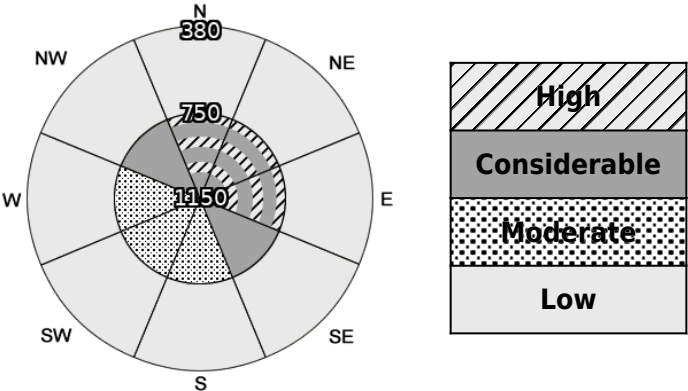

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New deposits of snow and windslab accumulations will become very unstable as the thaw conditions and rain penetrates the snowpack. Avalanches will occur on steep slopes and aspects above 750 metres but mainly on North-West and North through to South-East aspect. Cornices will also become unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight sleet, then snow showers on strong South then South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will fluctuate between 550 and 800 metres. Early morning, warmer weather will bring heavy rain at to all levels as the freezing level rapidly rises to 1500 metres.

Comments

Its a complex forecast with variable winds and fluctuating freezing levels. It should get a little colder towards the end of tomorrow
