

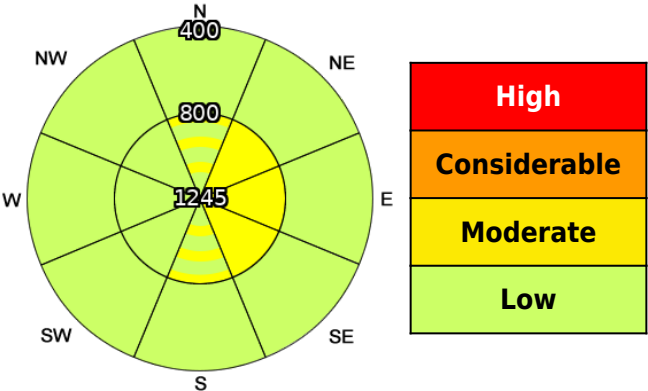

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will re-freeze and generally become well bonded and stable on most aspects and levels. Some localised instabilities will exist in the new snow deposits on mainly steep North-East to South East aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day the freezing level will lower to 900 metres. In the evening light snow showers are expected with moderate Westerly winds, it will be dry in the day with a light South-Eastly winds.

Great snow-ice conditions continue with freeze thaw cycles. Serious run outs.
