

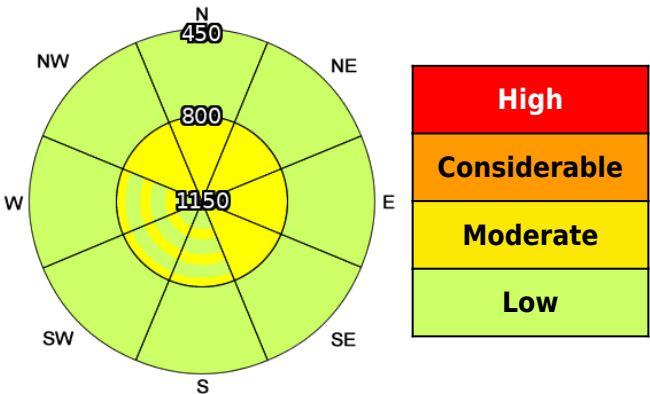

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 10/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Above 600 metres the dry and cooler conditions will help improve snowpack stability. On steep North through East to South-East aspects some moderately bonded layers will still exist within the snowpack. On other aspects the snowpack will be generally well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight fluctuating freezing levels will bring a mixture of rain, sleet and snow with Westerly winds. The day will be dry with South-East winds and the freezing at about 900 metres.

Comments

Conditions slowly improving, with a clear dry day forecast.
