

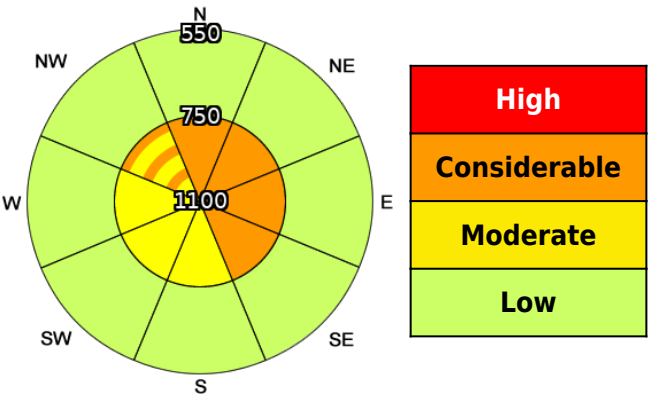

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 10/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh deposits of windslab will develop with any additional snow showers overnight. Where these accumulate and achieve depth new snow instabilities will exist, as gully exits and flanks cross-load with new deposits on steep North through East to South East aspects above 750m. The stability of all cornices will remain questionable and best avoided. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Temperatures will fluctuate with snow showers overnight to 650m. Moderate winds, initially Westerly will become South-Westerly as the showers die out during Thursday. Freezing levels will lower from 900m to around 500m.
