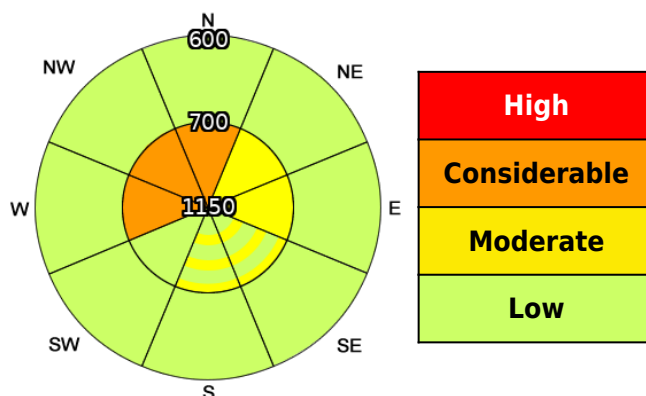


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 11/02/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

New accumulations will form on West to Northerly aspects above 700 metres. As snow turns to rain new accumulations will become increasingly unstable particularly on steeper terrain, gully exits, scarp slopes and avalanches are likely. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Initially it will remain cold with moderate snow falling on South-East winds. As the freezing levels rise there will be persistent rain later in the afternoon.

Comments

Worth checking latest forecasts. Likely to become very wet later in the day. Freezing levels due to reach 1200 metres.
