Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Windslab will continue to develop on the already weakly bonded snowpack. Avalanches are likely on North-Westerly to North-Easterly aspects above 850 metres. Due to cross loading localised deposits will affect other areas. Elsewhere the snowpack will remain firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

Forecast Weather Influences

Light snowfall overnight will become heavier on Sunday. The winds will be strong Southerly and the freezing level will rise to 1000 metres.
