

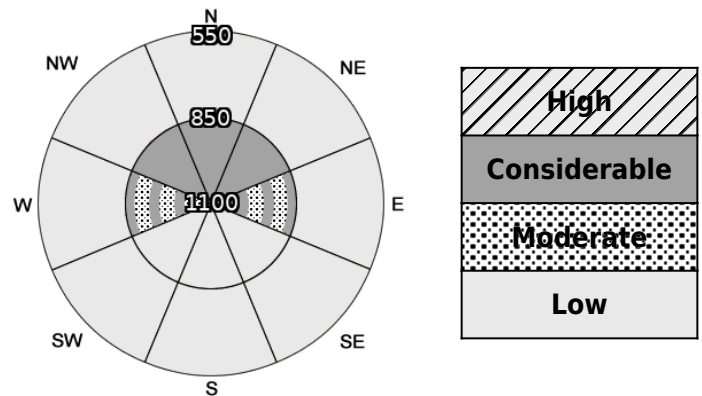

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snow will continue to drift and form poorly stabilised windslab on all North-West through North to North-East aspects above 850m where avalanches are likely. Some East facing gullies will have snow cross-loaded on to multi-aspects exit slopes. New weakly formed cornices will develop over many very steep lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

Light snow showers overnight and during the day. Winds will be strong Southerly.
