



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 14/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable snow will continue to form in areas sheltered from the Southerly winds. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North-West, North and North-East aspects above 900m. Avalanches will occur in these locations notably as the temperature rises during the day. Sheltered locations on other aspects will also be affected. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a dry night, further snow showers are expected. The freezing level will rise during the day.
