



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Windslab accumulations will continue to develop on the already weakly bonded snowpack. Avalanches will occur mainly on steep West through North to North-East aspects above 800 metres. Due to cross loading other aspects will also be affected. Cornices will be weak and unstable. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will be mostly dry with light South winds. During the day significant sleet and snow will develop on moderate South-East winds. The freezing level will fall from 1100 metres to 1000 metres.
