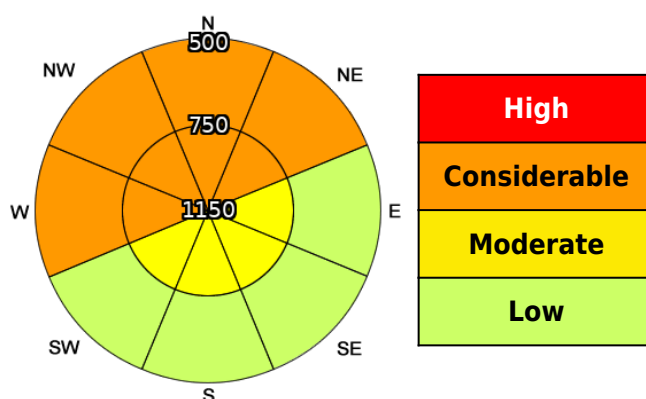


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 14/02/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

In this continuing cycle of snowfall and fluctuating freezing level avalanches are likely on North-West to North-East aspects above 750 metres. Areas of special concern are rapid cornice development on Northerly quadrant aspects and the deep accumulations on high steep aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Further heavy snowfalls are forecast with a fluctuating freezing level, going as high as 1000m. Winds will be from the South backing South-East and strengthening later.

Comments

Certainly the weather of the past few days is building to a more widespread avalanche cycle. Tonight will give some settlement and consolidation but tomorrow further snow may bring some weakly bonded locations to critical load. Precise timing is difficult to determine, watch for localised changes of freezing level during the day.
