

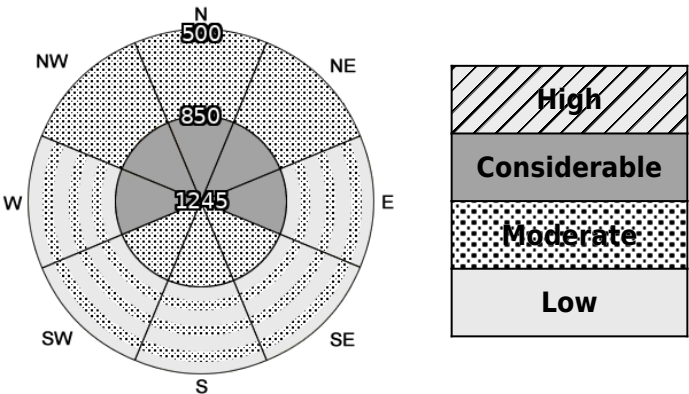

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded windslab will continue to build onto West through North to Easterly aspects mainly above 850 metres where avalanches are likely, other aspects and levels will be also be affected due to cross loading. Large unstable cornices will continue to form above North facing slopes and gullies, these will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, snow showers will continue with strong Southerly winds, showers dying out in the day as the wind becomes South-Easterly and strengthens. The freezing level will be at 600 metres.
