


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 15/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Whilst some consolidation of the existing snowpack will take place additional windslab accumulations will maintain marginal stability on steep North-West through North to East aspects above 850m. Most affected areas will be gully exits and the top of steep scarp slopes with cross-loading onto steep gully flanks above 850m. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Further snow showers are forecast overnight accompanied by strong South then South-Easterly winds. Freezing levels will remain around 600m.

Comments

Although forecast dry for Tuesday moderate to strong winds will continue to develop windslab in highest sheltered lee locations during the day.
