

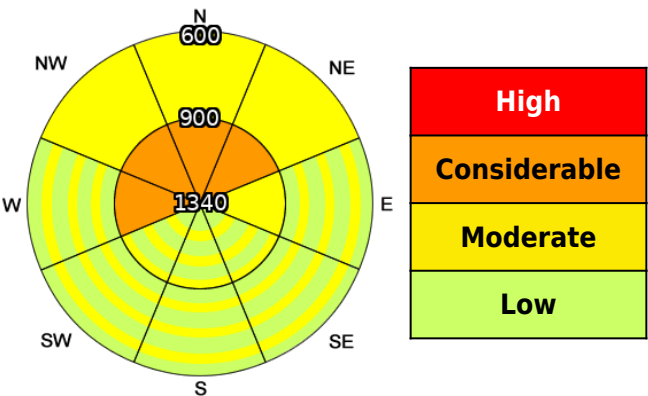
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 15/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh areas of poorly bonded windslab will be deposited on top of the already significant areas of moderately bonded windslab that exists on mainly North-West through North to North- East aspects above 900 metres where avalanches are likely. Through the day the strong winds will re-deposit additional unstable windslab onto Westerly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After overnight snow showers a generally dry day is expected. Moderate Southerly winds will back to the South-East and strengthen. The freezing level will be around 750 metres.
