


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE HIGH

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 16/02/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability will remain poor with additional accumulations of weakly stabilised fresh wind slab continuing to develop above 800m on mainly North-West to North-Easterly aspects where avalanches will occur, especially in steep sheltered gullies of multi aspects and around coire rims. Localised unsupported pillows of new snow and new cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be High.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Further snow showers are forecast overnight and during the day with strong South-East and Easterly winds. Freezing levels between 600m to 700m.

#### Comments

Poor mountain weather with white out conditions at times in plateau areas on Tuesday, looking much the same for Wed. Careful route selection with awareness of very changeable underfoot conditions required.
