

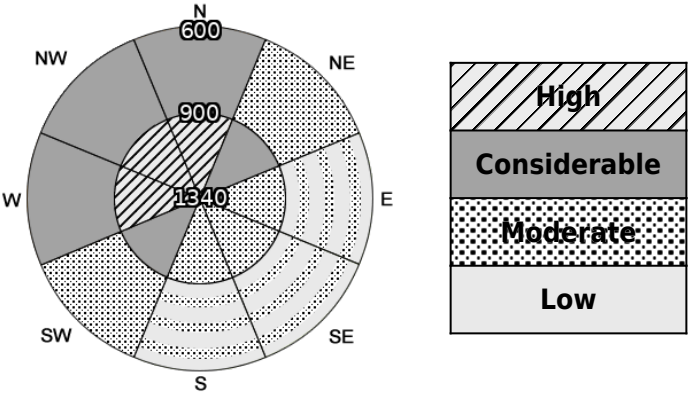

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 16/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow and strong winds will continue to deposit poorly bonded windslab. The greatest accumulations will occur on West to North aspects, and in other locations sheltered locations above 900 metres where avalanche will occur. Freshly formed cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight snow will ease and become patchy during the day. Strong winds from the East or South-East will ease slightly through the day. The freezing level will be around 750 metres.

Comments

Strong winds and significant drifting expected to continue overnight and through Wednesday morning.
