

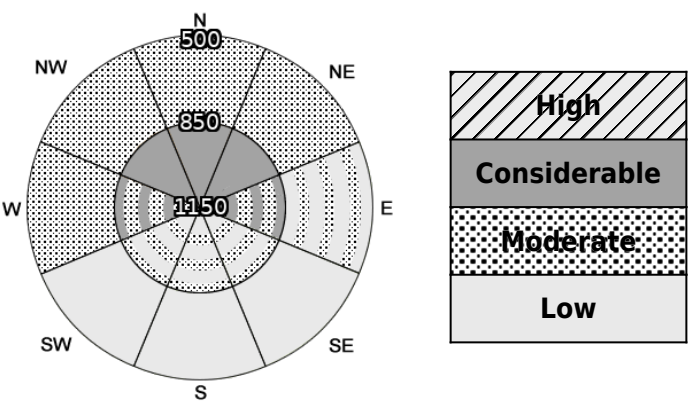

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 17/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

On steep West through North to North-East aspects above 800 metres weak instabilities will remain within the snowpack. Bonding between the multi snowpack layers is poor and avalanches are likely, areas particularly effected are gully exits flanks and steep scarp slopes, cornices are also fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Some light snow showers during the first part of the night then dry most most of the day. Winds South-East becoming variable, then South-South-East. Freezing level at 800 metres.

Comments

Some slope aspects are hard packed and wind scoured with Sastrugi. It should be a dry day with summit temperatures around minus 3 degrees.
