

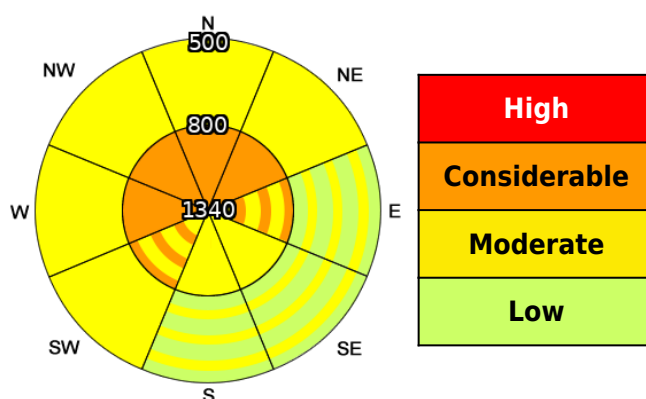
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 17/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further drifting will take place and unstable windslab will be present in sheltered gullies, hollows and on slopes with mainly West through North to North-East aspects above 800 metres, here avalanches are likely. Sheltered locations on other aspects will also be affected. Recently formed cornices will remain fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers are expected overnight with moderate South-Easterly winds. The day is expected to be dry with the wind initially light and variable in direction then strengthening and becoming moderate South-South-Easterly. The freezing level will be around 800 metres.
