

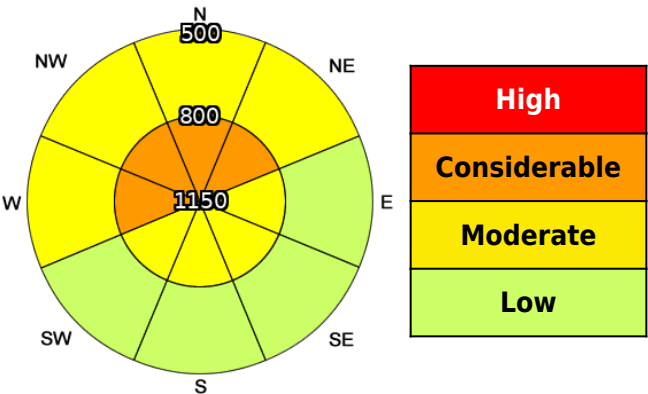

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 18/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snowfall will further deposit onto areas of poorly bonded windslab on the West through North to North-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Instabilities will also remain within the substantial accumulations of older windslab deposits which already exist on these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A few snow showers are expected through the forecast period. South-South-Easterly winds will strengthen overnight and through the day. The freezing level will be around 700 metres.

Comments

Strong Southerly winds expected to be a significant feature of the weather for the next few days.
