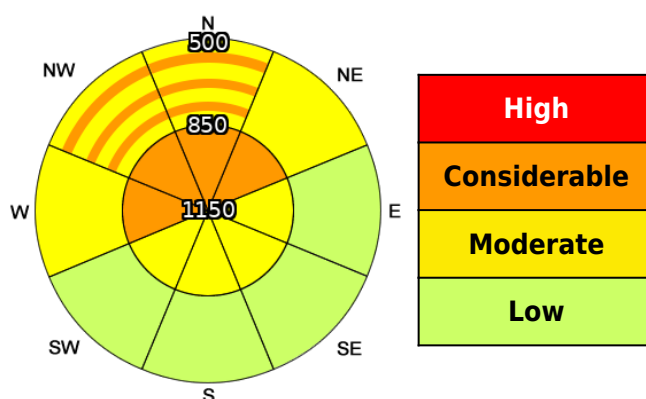

New snow will drift and add to the existing, poorly bonded windslab accumulations that are present on mainly West through North to North-Easterly aspects above 850 metres where avalanches are likely. Corrie rims and gully exits will be especially affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight and during the day snow showers with increasingly strong to very strong South-South-Easterly winds are expected. Freezing level at 700 metres, falling to 500 metres in the day.
