

**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE HIGH****Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 19/02/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Deep unstable windslab will exist in many sheltered areas such as deep hollows, gullies and on slopes with a West through North to Easterly aspect mainly above 600 metres, here Avalanches will occur and especially where deep accumulations of windslab have formed. The avalanche hazard will be High.

**High****Considerable****Moderate****Low****Forecast Weather Influences**

Stormy conditions will affect the area overnight and for much of Saturday with severe gales from the South or South-East. There will be heavy snow overnight becoming occasional showers on Saturday. The freezing level will be 400 metres.

**Comments**

Windslab formations and cornices will be very weakly bonded after overnight stormy conditions. It will remain fairly windy through much of the day.
