

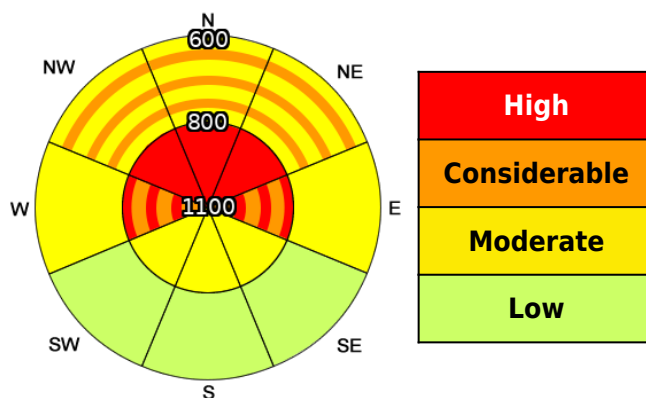
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE HIGH

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 19/02/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh weakly stabilised windslab will form mainly on steep, sheltered North West through North to North-East aspects above 800m, where avalanches will occur. Stability will also be poor as accumulations become cross-loaded and gain depth on gully flanks of other aspects and at lower elevations to 600m. The avalanche hazard will be High.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy snow is forecast overnight bringing blizzards and drifting in storm force South to South -Easterly winds, snow showers are to ease during the day with Freezing levels remaining around 400m.
