

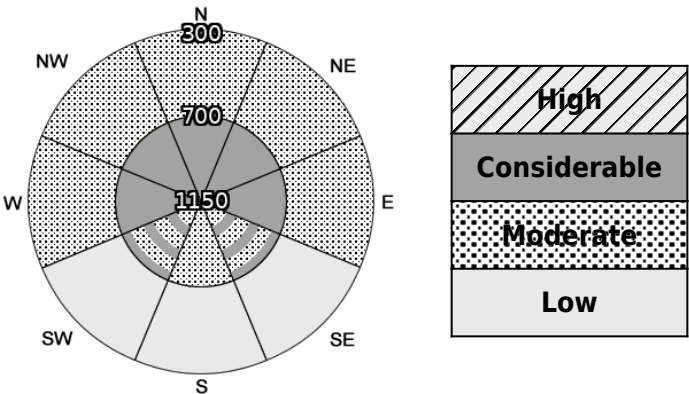

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 20/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Deep unstable windslab will exist in sheltered areas such as deep hollows, summit gullies and on slopes with a West through North to Easterly aspect mainly above 700 metres where Avalanches are likely especially where deep accumulations of windslab exist. Cornices will also be weakly bonded and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be mainly dry with the possibility of some light snow flurries overnight. Winds will be strong from a Southerly direction. The freezing level will be 800 metres.

Comments

Deep windslab formations and cornices will remain weakly bonded. Winds will remain strong across the summits. Good extensive cover of snow above 700 metres on many slopes.
