

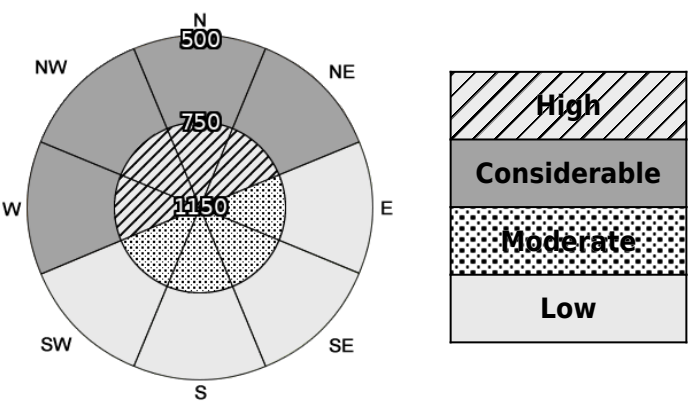

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

With temperatures remaining cold the weak bonds in the snowpack will be preserved. Winds will continue to transport and further load areas of wind slab on West through North-West to North-East aspects above 700 metres where avalanches will occur. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Temperatures will remain reasonably cold, with the freezing level at 700 metres. Winds will be strong across the tops. There will be no new snow.
