

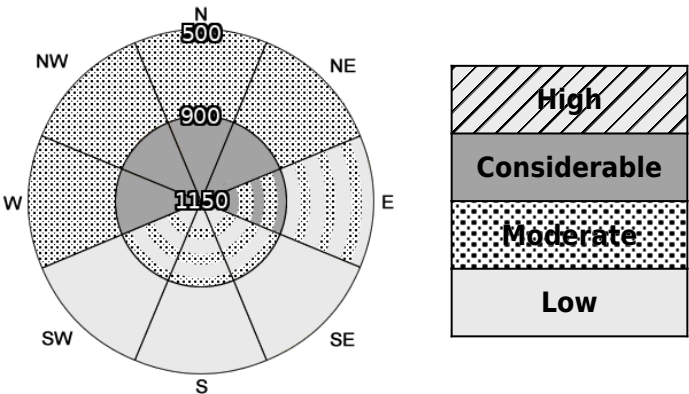

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 21/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of moderate to weakly bonded windslab will exist in many sheltered summit gullies and on slopes with a West through North to Easterly aspect mainly above 900 metres, Gully exits steep scarp slopes and corniced areas will be particularly affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will remain strong from the South overnight backing South-East by morning. Light snow will affect the area throughout the period. The freezing level will be 600 metres overnight rising to 800 metres through the day.

Comments

New snow only expected to be light and patchy. Good extensive cover of existing snow above 700 metres on many slopes.
