

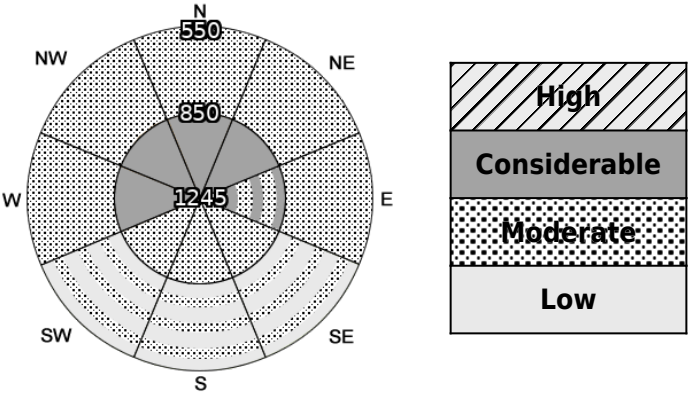

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 21/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting will continue and avalanches are likely on steep Westerly through North to North-Easterly aspects above 850 metres. Isolated accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will also lie on these aspects below this level. Other areas will be affected by cross loading and cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A mostly dry night will be followed by occasional light snow showers during the day. The winds will be strong Southerly backing South-Easterly with the freezing level below the summits.

Comments

Very poor visibility in the Cairngorms today mainly from the heavy drifting caused by strong winds.
