



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow pack stability has generally improved due to gradual settlement and consolidation. Isolated pockets of wind slab may develop on North-West to Northerly aspects above 750 metres. This will be mainly on Corrie rims, gully tops and steep unsupported slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers are expected overnight on light Southerly winds with a freezing level of 650 metres. Tomorrow there will be some flurries of snow on similar winds with the freezing level rising to 850 metres.

Comments

A layer of surface rime has formed on many slopes making travel on foot awkward.
