

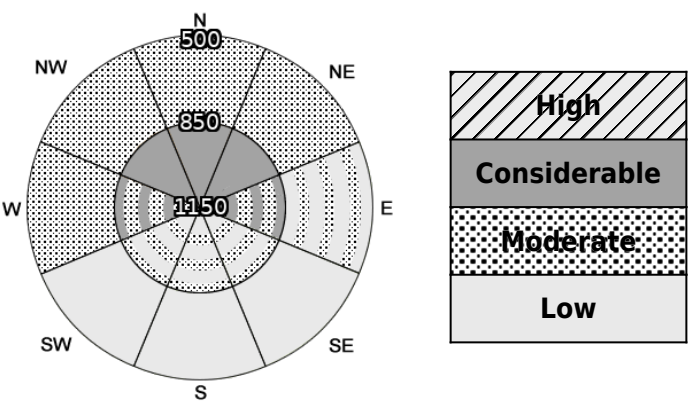

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 22/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of moderate to weakly bonded windslab will exist in many sheltered summit gullies and on slopes with a West through North to Easterly aspect mainly above 850 metres. Gully exits,steep scarp slopes and corniced areas will be particularly affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be patchy snow showers overnight becoming mainly dry on Tuesday. Winds will be fresh from the South.

Comments

New snow only expected to be light and patchy. Good extensive cover above 700 metres on many slopes. Cornices will remain prone to collapse.
