

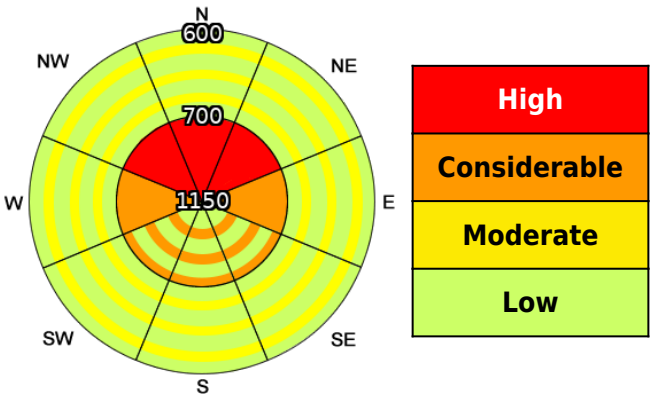

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 23/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The mild and very wet conditions will saturate and reduce the snowpack at all levels. Wet snow instabilities will exist on many steep slopes where avalanches will occur. Cornices will collapse. Sheltered summit gullies of all aspects and slopes with a West through North to Easterly aspect will be the most affected. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Wet mild and windy overnight and on Wednesday. Heavy rain with freezing levels above the tops and strong to gale force winds from a generally Southerly direction.

Comments

Heavy rain overnight then dry for a time before more heavy rain on Wednesday. Hazard of falling rock and ice will exist.
