

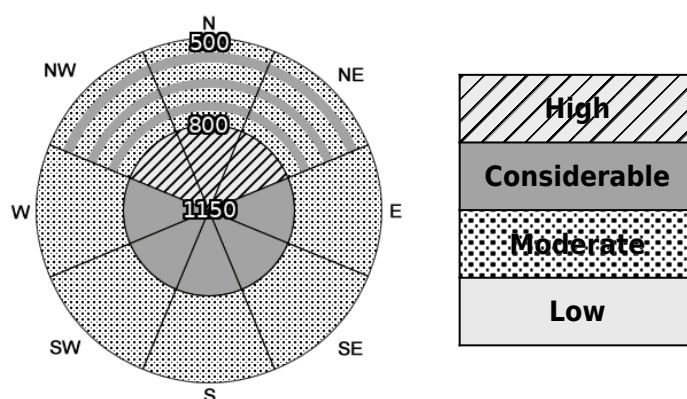

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

With the onset of rain there will be a period when the snowpack will be very weakly bonded. Avalanches will occur mainly on North-West through North to North-East aspects. Loose snow avalanches are likely on lower elevations on steep ground. Cornices will be very weak and likely to pull out deeper instabilities below. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy rain up to the highest summits is forecast. There will be strong gusty winds veering from South to South-West.
