



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 24/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw. Surface instabilities will remain on the steepest slopes on all aspects above 950 metres with North-West to North-East aspects especially affected. Below this level the snowpack will be generally stable. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will be well above summit levels and during the day it is expected to be around 3000 metres. Very strong South-Westerly winds with rain throughout the period.

Comments

Remaining wet for thursday but cold again friday, Freezing Level expected to be at 500m.
