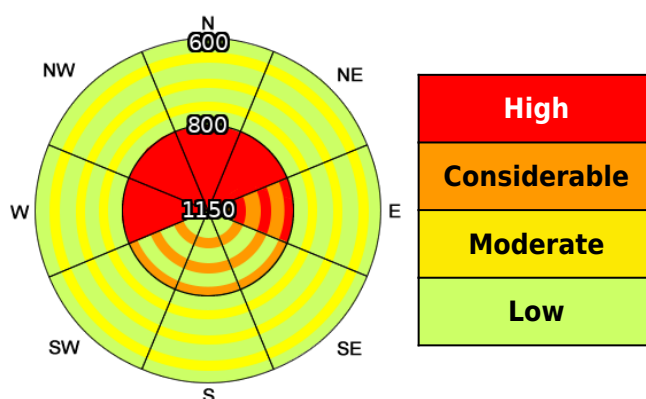


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE HIGH**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 24/02/2011****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will remain very wet, becoming more saturated at all levels, avalanches will occur on West through North to North-East aspects mainly above 800 metres. Other slope aspects will have localised wet snow instabilities. Cornices will collapse triggering slopes below them. The avalanche hazard will be High.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight, rain showers these will continue through most of the day, the winds will be South-Westerly reaching Storm force at times. The freezing level will be rising to 3000 metres with plus 10 degrees forecast at summit level.

Comments

A miserable forecast with very strong winds, some gusts are forecast to reach 100mph! Rivers and streams will be high.
