

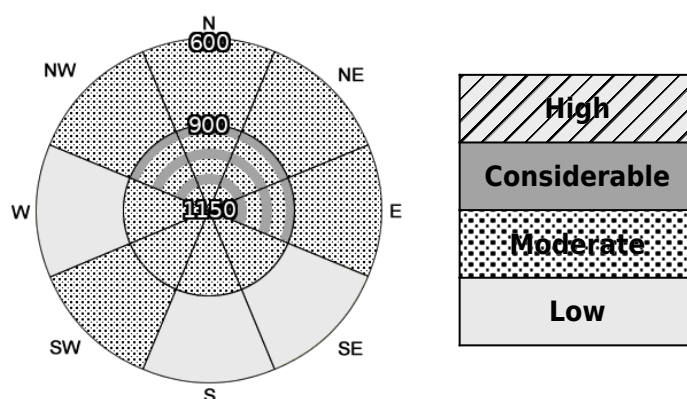

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The deeper snowpack is generally well bonded. Wet snow surface instability persists on very steep ground above 900 metres, particularly in isolated areas on North-West through North to East aspects where avalanches are likely. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

More rain is forecast although not as heavy. Temperatures will remain warm with moderate to strong South-West winds.

Comments

Cornice and water hazard exist. The water hazard is due to weak bridges on rising burns., The Friday forecast for cooling is well needed.
