


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 24/02/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability will remain marginal at highest elevations above 1000m on very steep North-West through North to North-East aspects. The snowpack will be generally stable below 950m although slumping cornice lines still remain a hazard. The snowpack will continue to moisten and small loose wet surface snow slides will occur on multi aspects of very steep gully side walls. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



#### Forecast Weather Influences

A strong, mild and wet South-Westerly airflow will persist overnight and during the day. Freezing levels will remain above summits at around 2000m.

#### Comments

Poor mountain conditions prevail for Wed. Ice and rock falls are also a consideration during thawing conditions.
