

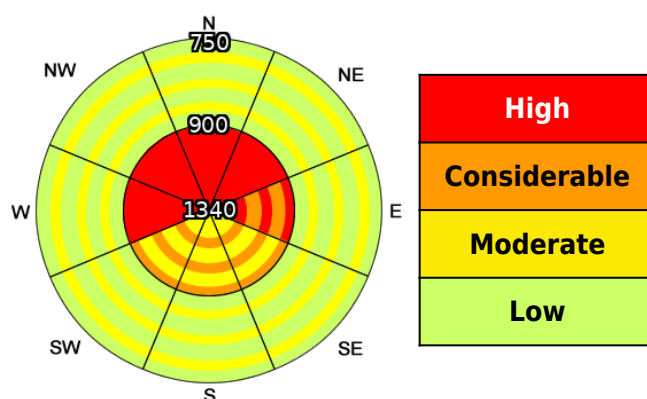

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 24/02/2011

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become increasingly saturated and wet snow instabilities will be present on steep slopes on most aspects. Sheltered gullies and slopes with West through North to North-East aspects above 900 metres will be most affected and here avalanches will occur. Cornices will collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level is expected to remain above the summits, with rain at all levels overnight and during the day. Winds are expected to be very strong South-Westerly.

Comments

In the thawing conditions rock and ice fall will be a hazard.
