


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 25/02/2011

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and slowly re-freeze, it will generally be well bonded and stable at all levels and on all aspects. Some surface instabilities may exist but these will be confined to the steepest slopes at the highest elevations mainly in the morning. Any remaining Cornices will continue to be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, light rain is expected with a freezing level well above the summits, this will continue into the morning but it will begin to get colder in the afternoon and the freezing level will lower to 900 metres. Winds will be strong South-Westerly.

#### Comments

Snowpack remains generally good and will be saved somewhat by colder temperatures tomorrow and the weekend.
