

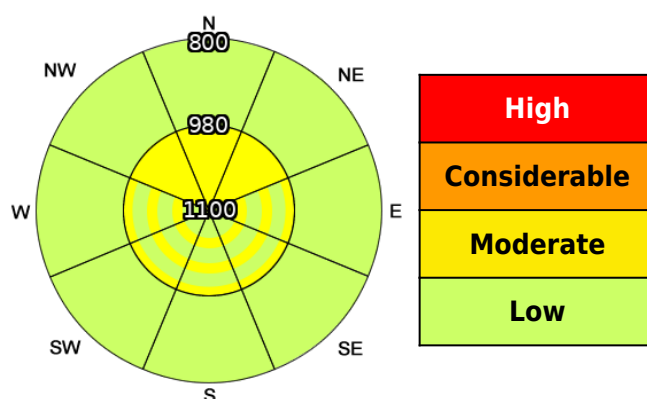

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some wet snow instabilities will remain at highest elevations above 980m on very steep North-West through North to North-East aspects until the arrival of colder conditions during the day. Stability will improve in all locations as the day progresses. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

A cold front will continue to bring outbreaks of rain overnight before dying out as colder, drier conditions affect the area from midday. Winds will be South-West and strong throughout.

Comments

Stability will be much improved as the freezing level drops during the day to around 900m.
